After 7 years of conservative performance due to transition, the economy in China achieved strong resilience in 2017 by hitting 6.9% GDP growth rate. In terms of the structure, tertiary industry bounced to a 51.6% share leading the combination of both primary agriculture and manufacturing sectors. Manufacturing is one of the largest business sectors at 28.5% of the gross value added (GVA) in 2017. SUSTA will be bringing key buyers from China to four Southern states, Tennessee, Mississippi, North Carolina and Virginia to meet with our southern exporters specializing in Yellow Pine Logs.
